JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work with education team to conduct ½ day experiential education field trips for 4th – 12th grade students and special groups, including: wildlife observation, biological sampling, water quality testing, ecosystem and watershed concepts, and safety review
- Manage and maintain educational and scientific equipment
- Job will require local travel
- Assist staff with program development
- This position involves seasonal exposure to the elements.
